Key Vocabulary	Definition
Stave	The five lines and spaces that music notes are written on.
Notation	Sign or symbol to identify when a sound is made in the music.
Bars	A way of putting music into sections, each bar has the same number of beats in it.
Pitch	High and low sounds in music
Tempo	The speed of the music.
structure	How different parts of music are put together. E.g. ABCA or verse chorus verse.
Phrase	A short section of music. Like a musical sentence!

### Key Knowledge

#### 'IN MY LIVERPOOL HOME'



Look at how the outline of the buildings goes high and low. Using 5 or 6 notes on a glockenspiel try and create a short melody with high and low sounds to represent a sound scape of this.
