



Year 1 and 2 Art & Design Curriculum Map 2024-26

Children to develop their drawing, painting, printing and sculpting skills across the five topics. Children will explore and respond to the work of the highlighted artists or significant periods in time through a range of media such as pencil, paint, fine line marker, pastel and collage. Children to use our CRIT language to talk about their work and begin to discuss the work of great artists. Autumn term will begin with basic skills activities to familiarise the children with different media. The children will use a range of tools throughout the topic and have opportunities to practise skills.
