

Year 6 trip – Go Outside, Formby

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have arranged a day trip for our Year 6 children to Go Outside – a 40 acre forest site in Formby. We will be getting the train to Formby and walking a short 15 minutes to Go Outside where the children will enjoy high energy, instructor-led tasks and missions that include forest skills, shelter building, a giant slip 'n' slide, assault course, a tunnel escape and much more.

Food

Children can bring their own packed lunch in a labelled carrier bag. Fizzy drinks, cans or energy drinks are not permitted. Please contact the school office on 01512886508 if your child is eligible for free school meals and you would like school to provide a packed lunch.

Children can bring snacks to have throughout the day e.g. cereal bars – no sweets or chewing gum

Kit List

Your child should be dressed appropriately:

- warm clothes (a warm jacket and trousers should be either worn, or brought in a bag)
- appropriate footwear (footwear should be suitable for physical activity, running, dirt and will almost certainly get wet)
- waterproof jacket (in case of rain)
- suncream (although in a forest, sunrays can still beam through so children should ensure they are wearing an appropriate factor according to child's skin. Children may want to bring their cream with them to reapply after getting wet)
- a water bottle (there are multiple locations around site to refill throughout the day)
- spare clothing (children will get wet so spare change of clothing is **essential**)

Please sign up and pay £5 on Parent Pay by Friday 30th June – this provides consent for your child to attend the day.
